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Remote Education Agreement – January 2021

Hardwicke Parochial Primary Academy has been asked by The Department for Education (DFE) to provide compulsory remote learning for all pupils who are off due to self-isolating from COVID-19.

In response to this provision the following agreement stands:

We (school) will:

- Set up every child with their own private TEAMS account
- Conduct a survey of at home provisions to enable full home learning to be accessed – SEPTEMBER 2020
- Make contact with all children who are absent from school awaiting test results and provide them with basic home learning support via the School Website
- Make contact with all children who are absent from school after receiving positive COVID results or have been told to Selfisolate by NHS Test and Trace
- Provide families who inform the school that they are isolating with daily home learning assignments and support from the Class teacher and Teaching Assessment. This will be through MS Teams Live Teaching provision or resources on the School Website.
- Provide children who are remotely learning with their a channel of communication and a safe and secure place to talk with staff and share work produced
- Support children who are remotely learning with their mental wellbeing via the School Website and if required through support via our Pastoral Team
- Notify you of any changes with timely communication

You (parents) will:

- Download and log in to TEAMS and inform the school if there are any difficulties in this
- Ensure your child is able to access their work set on a secure home device
- Ensure your child is up and ready every day to complete their assigned work and that it is submitted in an appropriate time scale
- Communicate with the school immediately if you or your child shows any symptoms of illness that requires remote learning to be paused
- Communicate with the office/teachers via phone, email or your child's private TEAMS channel about any additional concerns or support you require
- Use lines of communication in an appropriate manner

You (children) will:

- Log in to TEAMS every day to check for new work or communication from staff
- Access and complete the work assigned within an appropriate timescale
- Complete all work assigned to the best of their ability
- Use the Class and/or private channel to talk to staff in a polite and respectful way
- Listen to the adult conducting remote lessons and follow their instructions
- Always follow our school rules and expectations
- Live by our 12 Christian Values e.g. perseverance, courage and honesty
