Communication

As you are all aware, communication came up as an issue in our school questionnaire so we are working hard to improve in this area.

Mrs Panton has introduced a system called Class Dojo which is accessed on an App. This will be a system which will enable easier communication between school and home. We will be trialling this for the next academic year.

Your child should have brought home a letter containing a QR code and instructions on how to download the app and connect with your new class. Teachers will be able to send messages and pictures to you, informing you of exciting moments during the day and if you have messages to send to the teacher, you will also be able to do so. We will try to answer these in a timely manner, and this will be during office hours only. You will also be able to see when your child has received house points.

On a more exciting note, your child's new teacher has made a short video clip for the class to see the exciting things that will be happening next year. We will post these on Class Dojo soon! This will also allow parents/careers to see your child's class teacher.



After School Clubs / Extra Curricular Activities

Teaching staff, including teaching assistants, choose to run clubs after school. These clubs vary depending on the teacher's skills and expertise. In the recent school questionnaire, parents seemed to be disappointed with these provisions.

Unfortunately, the clubs were not always well-attended, and some had to be cancelled due to low participation. I will be sending out a Google Docs form next week to gather your input on which clubs you would like to see offered at school. However, please note that the availability of these clubs depends on the teachers' availability and expertise. Your input is crucial in helping us improve our offerings, so please take the time to complete the form.

We are still hopeful that we can run Sports Day next week and are hoping to run it over two mornings. Further communication will be sent out on Monday outlining further details.
